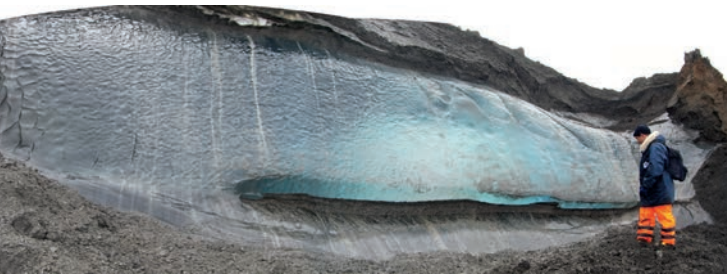


About Us

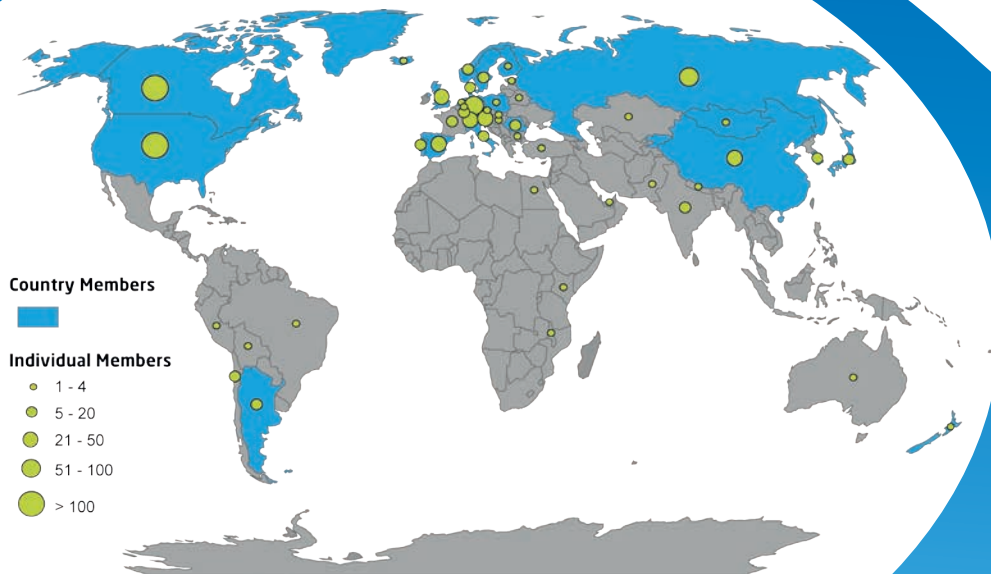
